## Annual Dues Structure

Tulsa Area Clean Cities is a membership based coalition of federal, state and local agencies, public interest groups, and public and private fleets who have joined together in a coordinated effort to promote the purchase and use of clean, American Fuels (AF) and Alternative Fuel Vehicles (AFV). The program is a self-sustaining coalition in good standing with National Clean Cities, Inc. and is funded through INCOG, the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, U.S. Department of Energy, and the U.S. Department of Transportation. We are a public agency, and your membership/contribution should be tax deductible. We count on a growing membership base to support the organization and its activities; you will be kept informed with a monthly stakeholder update, and through participation in Clean Cities sponsored events, meetings, and transportation deployment projects and initiatives.

**Infrastructure Industry:** manufacturers, suppliers, dealers, distributors, and others for who are involved in the manufacture, production, distribution, sale and/or installation of components or systems relating to fuel infrastructure. (Dues: \$1,500)

**Transportation Industry:** delivery, carriers, solid waste haulers, manufacturers of components and others for whom transportation forms a vital element of their business. (Dues: \$1,500)

**Automotive Industry:** manufacturers, suppliers, dealers, distributors, and others who are involved in the manufacture, production, distribution, sale and/or installation of components or whole goods relating to automotive vehicles. (Dues: \$1,500)

**Private:** representatives from other businesses and organizations who are not members of the Infrastructure Industry, Transportation, or Automotive Industry. (Dues: \$1,000)

**Public:** representatives from tribal, local, state, and federal government or public agencies. Clean Cities dues are included in INCOG member governments' regular dues payments. INCOG members are not required to pay dues directly to Clean Cities. (Dues: \$150)

**Non-profit/Education:** Non-profits or educational organization involved in promoting clean fuels. (Dues: \$150)

**Friend:** any individual from the general public who is committed to promoting clean fuels. (Dues: \$50)
